- 3 – j)** Hand-powered sheep shears to cut wool
- 4 – k)** Stovepipe damper to control the amount of air reaching the fire in a stove
- 5 – g)** Combination tool with glass cutter, can opener, and other tools
- 6 – m)** Mrs. Potts' sad irons for ironing clothes
- 7 – n)** Hand-cranked ice-cream freezer
- 8 – c)** Stove lifter to lift the hot burners from wood stoves
- 9 – f)** Kitchen meat saw to cut through bones
- 10 – a)** Wire balloon fly trap to catch flies
- 11 – b)** Wire dish cover, set of 5, to keep flies off food
- 12 – o)** Fruit and vegetable press to purée cooked fruits and vegetables
